CRISIS FOR LIFE4KIDS

Last month, we told you about the challenges faced in the current Life4Kids home in Nairobi. The situation has dramatically worsened.

Notice was received that the house currently occupied by Life4Kids in Nairobi does not have proper zoning or land use permission. In addition, the home was apparently constructed without proper approvals and inspections and is therefore **illegal**. The City has threatened to **tear the house down**. While this situation apparently affects other homes in the area, and the Landlord has told Life4Kids just to ignore the warning, an enquiry at the City disclosed that this is an **imminent and extreme situation**.

And, as if **further bad news** was needed, just a few days again, Life4Kids received a further notice from the City that **taxes have not been paid** on the home (that is the responsibility of the Landlord). Life4Kids has been told to pay rent to the City. But, if that is done, the Landlord will terminate the lease agreement and **evict the boys**.

Ready for more bad news? Last month we indicated that Life4Kids was negotiating to rent a new home with an option to buy. That too has changed! The owner of that home really wants to sell and has received other expressions of interest. While he feels bound to sell to us, we must pay a substantial down payment now and pay the total purchase price by January. The purchase price plus funds required for renovations and furnishing will approach \$250,000.

But how do we raise \$250,000 in three months?
